FALL BIBLE STUDIES

TUESDAY MORNING: Held on campus offering childcare, beginning September 12, 10:00 AM - 12:00 PM.

- **Priscilla Shirer Study on Jonah.** (*Ladies*) Led by Vicki Mullins, this study will help you redefine interruption and see that your interruptions are actually God's invitation to do something beyond your wildest dreams. Cost \$15. **Childcare** is available by reservation only and the cost is \$20 per family for the semester. Childcare reservations must be made by August 27.

WEDNESDAY EVENING: Beginning August 23. 6:00-7:20 PM

- **Priscilla Shirer Study on Gideon.** (*Ladies*) The study of *Gideon: Your weakness - God's strength* will be facilitated by Jennifer Gay and Tonya Box. This study will encourage you to recognize your weakness as the key that the Lord gives you to unlock the full experience of His strength in your life. Cost is \$15.
- **The WISE Women group (Women In Search of Encouragement).** (*Ladies*) This study/fellowship group will delve into **Be Encouraged**, a study on 1 Corinthians, by Warren Wiersbe. Cost: \$10.
- **Precept Study on James.** (*Ladies*) What is true faith? Each verse of this practical study, led by Bonita Lyons, is alive with instructions, admonition, and encouragement. Learn God's principles for dealing with trials, temptations, the tongue, and the pull of the world. Cost: \$25.
- **From Beginning to End, How Now Shall We Live.** (*COED*) This course, taught by Richard Fisher, broadly explores God's primeval command to Adam, "but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat" (Gen. 2:17), through world history, from its beginning, until today, and a future state of reward and punishment. "From Beginning to End, How Now Shall We Live" is adapted from *How Now Shall We Live* by Colson and Percy, *We Still Hold These Truths* by Spalding, *Never Before in History* by Amos and Gardiner, and *The Conscience of the Constitution - The Declaration of Independence and the Right to Liberty* by Sandefur. Emphasis will be given to The Declaration of Independence - our National Charter. Cost: NA
- **33: The Series.** (*Men*) This Bible study for men is all about setting men up to live lives of truth, passion and purpose. Cost: \$15.

THURSDAY MORNING: Held off campus (childcare NOT available), beginning September 21.

- **"What Would Jesus Say?"** (*Ladies*) The phrase "What Would Jesus Do" has permeated our society, but the greater question is "What Does Jesus Say?" This study, led by LeAnn Allen, will be held at Becky Parrish's house from 10:00 AM - 12:00 PM. Cost is \$15.
